As part of an European research project on rare diseases (EJP-RD), a joint team (CHU Toulouse/Inserm Unit 1295) is coordinating a research project on non-progressive congenital ataxia or ataxic cerebral palsy. The overall aim of this project is to improve knowledge of non-progressive congenital ataxia by seeking further evidence to understand its origin, predict its natural history and measure its impact.
