Citoyens et Recherche/Seintinelles is a charity whose vocation is **to promote and enable a much closer collaboration between citizens and researchers on cancer research** (mostly on topics related to quality of life, side effects and prevention).

We have a community in France of 38 255 citizens (les Seintinelles) and 736 researchers engaged with us. During the last 10 years, we took part in 65 researches, generated 112 000 participations, which led to 26 articles.

After proving that we can mutualize and massify recruitment for non-interventional researches, we want to take it the next level and we have **huge ambitions in promoting and enabling through mutualization participative research in cancerology in France and in Europe**

Our scientific project manager will be in charge of bringing this ambition to life, as well as raising our profile as a key partner on EU projects. .
